**Introduction**

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focus on both rural and urban areas, categorized under Swachh Bharat Mission-Gramin (SBM-G) and Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban (SBM-U). The state government, along with local authorities, worked to promote toilet construction, ensure proper sanitation practices, and raise awareness about the importance of cleanliness and hygiene through various campaigns and initiatives under the SBM framework. The villagers were informed about various government schemes and subsidies available for building toilets, encouraging them to take advantage of these benefits.

4. To encourage maintaining social distancing and other safety protocols.

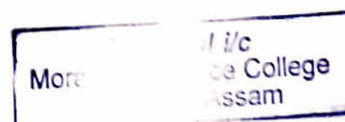
**Explanation:**

Health camps are the hope for the poor people who cannot afford to pay for treatment expenses or medicines. Health Camps are effective way to of delivering public the primary health care.

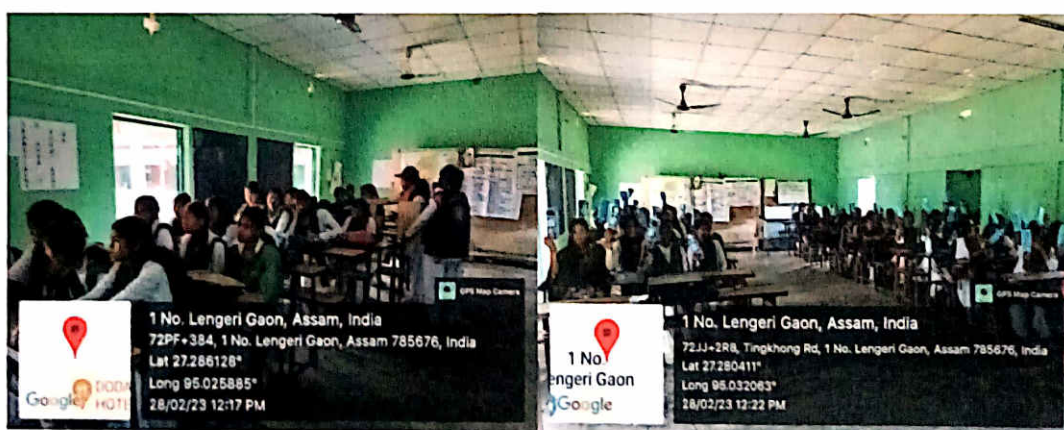

She wrote the Vaishnavite scripture 'Nam Ghosa' in 2016, which Shri Madhabdev wrote in Assamese between 1568 and 1596. She encourages the students to engage in creative activities, promote local art and culture and brought them to the rural entrepreneurs to learn and innovate entrepreneurial works.
